<u>January 30, 2025 - Session 1</u>

Are We Ready for Tier 2; Developing a Tier 2 Team; Data Decision Rules

- Review essential PBIS Tier 1 characteristics to ensure implementation with fidelity.
- Use data to determine your building's readiness for Tier 2 development.
- Learn why it is essential to establish a Tier 2 Leadership Team that is composed of the recommended membership.
- Develop an efficient and effective process for gathering and reviewing relevant student data utilizing multiple data sources.

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February 13, 2025 - Session 2

Screeners; Reverse Request for Assistance Audit of Intervention Systems; Targeted Interventions; Check and Connect

- Become familiar with Screening Tools.
- Understand the purpose of a Reverse Request for Assistance.
- Understand how to use data to audit interventions of Tier 2 Systems
- Understand the importance of selecting interventions that are matched to student needs.
- Become familiar with the Check and Connect components

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<u>February 27, 2025 - Session 3</u>

CICO: Check In, Check Out; Social, Academic Instructional Groups (SAIG); Self-Monitoring

- Understand the key components of CICO.
- Identify data that targets students for SAIG support.
- Become familiar with the different components of Social, Academic Instructional Groups (SAIG).
- Understand the importance of using Daily Progress Reports (DPR) when implementing SAIG.
- Be aware of how to align an intervention with the corresponding deficit.
- Undetstand the "Who" and "How" of Self-Monitoring.
